Echavarría's contributions have not gone unnoticed; she was named Artist of the Year 2023 at the DSWF exhibition in London. Her art has graced galleries in Copenhagen, Mallorca, Miami, and her native Medellín, with appearances at prestigious events like Miami Art, Palm Beach Art, and Wynwood Art.
